ARTICLE 2

Shall the voters of said school district approve the school board to expend \$13,760,921 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$14,032.09 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 7.25% higher than spending for the current year. BY AUSTRALIAN BALLOT

ARTICLE 3

Shall the voters of said school district approve the school board to expend up to \$200,000 for scheduled roof replacements? It is estimated that this expenditure, if approved, will result in education spending of \$231.66 per equalized pupil. This spending per equalized pupil is not higher than spending for the current fiscal year. It is also estimated that if this proposed expenditure and the proposed budget (Article 2) are both approved, education spending per equalized pupil will increase by \$1,179.88, or 9.02% over such spending for the current fiscal year.
