

Pursuant to Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 1971, Title 23 Vermont Statutes Annotated Sections 1008 and 3510, the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Fairfax hereby adopt the following ordinance.

Operation of All Terrain Vehicles

1. Definitions

- A. All terrain vehicle, or ATV, shall be defined as any non-highway recreational vehicle, except snowmobiles, as defined by 23 VSA 3201 (5), used for cross country travel on trails, or on any one or more of the following: land, water, snow, ice, marsh, swampland or natural terrain.
- B. Public road shall include all parts of any bridge, culvert, roadway, street, square, fairground, or other place open temporarily or permanently to public or general circulation of vehicles.

2. Operation

- A. No person may operate, or permit to be operated, an all terrain vehicle, owned by him or under his control, on any public road in the Town of Fairfax.
- B. No person may operate, or permit to be operated, an all terrain vehicle, owned by him or under his control, on any privately owned land, unless the operator or a member of his immediate family is the owner of said land, or unless the operator has on his person, written consent of the owner of said land.

3. Fines for violations of this ordinance shall be set pursuant to 23 VSA 1008.

Any resident may contact a Selectman for more information. The full text of the ordinance appears herein. Five percent (5%) of the voters may petition for a special meeting of the Town to see if the ordinance should be disapproved. If no petition is filed, the ordinance will become effective sixty (60) days for the date of adoption.
